INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Blessington Tidy Towns 3-Year Plan!

This plan is to be used the guide the work of Blessington Tidy Towns for the next 3 years. The plan was drawn up following consultation with members of the Tidy Towns group, action items open from our last plan and following surveys undertaken in the Blessington Community during 2018 and early 2019.

The plan does not set out to include all of the work that will carried out by Blessington Tidy Towns but to provide direction for the group over the next few years. First of all we set out the Key Projects - major projects that will have greatest impact on Blessington. Then we have a yearly schedule of tasks that will address the different Tidy Towns categories.

KEY PROJECTS

These are the Key Projects for Blessington Tidy Towns for 2019-2022. These are the projects we believe will have the greatest impact on the town, its landscape and natural environment over this time. They are also the projects that will demand the greatest time and resources of Blessington Tidy Towns and its supporters.

KEY PROJECT 1: GREEN SPACES & LANDSCAPING

Blessington e-GREENWAY

This will be BTT's biggest project ever and will see the extension of the existing 8Km greenway to around the lake side. The new e-Greenway will be fully accessible, have charging points along the route for electronic devices from phones to e-bikes. We believe it will be one of Irelands top tourist attractions and amenities. With support from Wicklow County Council, the ESB and Irish Water, we believe this project will succeed.

KEY PROJECT 2: SUSTAINABILITY - DOING MORE WITH LESS



EV CHARGING POINTS

BTT is seeking to have a number of Electric Vehicle Charging stations added in our town. These EV Stations will be located at prime locations in the town, to include Blessington Square, Supervalu, and the Primary Care Centre. The project should be a joint effort of BTT, WCC and local businesses.

KEY PROJECT 3: COMMUNITY - YOUR PLANNING & INVOLVEMENT



TIDY TOWNS NETWORK SEMINAR

BTT are lucky to have been in a position to be able to attend previous national tidy towns conferences and we see a gap for something similar in Wicklow. We propose to organise our own mini tidy towns conference, with speakers on key areas of interest and to open it to groups in Wicklow and Kildare.

KEY PROJECT 4: NATURE & BIODIVERSITY IN YOUR LOCALITY

NEIGHBOURHOOD WOOD

BTT would like to develop a small woodland on an area of waste ground near Carrig Glen estate. This land is in County Council ownership. This is an ideal site for management for biodiversity. This project will include access (from the proposed greenway), interpretation panels on biodiversity and potential for creation of additional habitat areas. Funding will be sought for this project in 2022/23.



KEY PROJECT 5: STREETSCAPE & PUBLIC PLACES

THE DOWNSHIRE MONUMENT RESTORATION AND CLEANING

It is proposed that BTT will take on a project to arrange for the prominent Downshire Monument in the Blessington Town Square to be cleaned, and restored to it's former glory, and to act as a focal point in the town once more.
