INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Blessington Tidy Towns 3-Year Plan!

This plan is to be used the guide the work of Blessington Tidy Towns for the next 3 years. The plan was drawn up following consultation with members of the Tidy Towns group, action items open from our last plan and following surveys undertaken in the Blessington Community during 2022.

The plan does not set out to include all of the work that will carried out by Blessington Tidy Towns but to provide direction for the group over the next few years. First of all we set out the Key Projects - major projects that will have greatest impact on Blessington. Then we have a yearly schedule of tasks that will address the different Tidy Towns categories, and in some cases may complete sooner than was originally anticipated.

KEY PROJECTS

These are the Key Projects for Blessington Tidy Towns for 2023-2025. These are the projects we believe will have the greatest impact on the town, its landscape and natural environment over this time. They are also the projects that will demand the greatest time and resources of Blessington Tidy Towns and its supporters.

KEY PROJECT 1: GREEN SPACES & LANDSCAPING

Blessington e-GREENWAY

This will be BTT's biggest project ever and will see the extension of the existing 8Km greenway to around the lake side. The new e-Greenway will be fully accessible, have charging points along the route for electronic devices from phones to e-bikes. We believe it will be one of Irelands top tourist attractions and amenities. With support from Wicklow County Council, the ESB and Irish Water, we believe this project will succeed.

KEY PROJECT 2: SUSTAINABILITY - DOING MORE WITH LESS



EV CHARGING POINTS

BTT is seeking to have a number of Electric Vehicle Charging stations added in our town. These EV Stations will be located at prime locations in the town, to include Blessington Square, SuperValu, WCC Yards. The project should be a joint effort of BTT, WCC and local businesses.

KEY PROJECT 3: COMMUNITY - YOUR PLANNING & INVOLVEMENT



INTEGRATION

BTT is seeking to work closely with the Blessington and District Forum, WCC, the Wicklow Volunteer Centre and other statutory bodies to integrate recent arrivals from different parts of the world for varying reasons into our local communities.

KEY PROJECT 4: NATURE & BIODIVERSITY IN YOUR LOCALITY

NEIGHBOURHOOD WOOD

BTT would like to develop a small woodland on an area of waste ground near Carrig Glen estate. This land is in County Council ownership. This is an ideal site for management for biodiversity. This project will include access (from the proposed greenway), interpretation panels on biodiversity and potential for creation of additional habitat areas. Funding will be sought for this project in 2023-2025.




KEY PROJECT 5: STREETSCAPE & PUBLIC PLACES

TOWN PARK AND PUBLIC REALM

Enure that the Blessington Town Park is delivered as part of he Cairns Development. Continue to strive for RRDF / **U**RDF funding under the Town Cenres First program to enhance the centre of Blessington, in particular along the main street.

Project Period: 2023-2025






KEY PROJECT 6: GREEN SPACES AND LANDSCAPING

BURGAGE CASTLE

BTT have been working with the Burgage Castle restoration group, a subgroup of the Blessington & District Forum, in partnership with the ESB, to maintain the ruins of Burgage Castle and to then develop it in to a point of interest along the route of the existing Blessington Greenway section. It is an ambitious project, but with a strong dedicated team anything is possible.....
